## NOTE

- Please do not add water over the Max water line.
- Never turn the unit upside down or tilted your steamer past a 45-degree angle.
- Never use the steamer on clothes that you are wearing on yourself.
- For perfect use-please use a hanger to hang your clothes while steaming.

- Hilife garment steamer is designed for use with 110 volt outlets and is available in the United States and Canada. However, if the power supply is not 110 V, we recommend using an adapter.

## **WARM TIPS**

1. Our Hilife garment steamer is designed for use with 110V-120 volt outlets and is available in the United States and Canada. However, if the power supply is not 120V, we recommend using an adapter.
2. The best way to keep your steamer in top condition is to use only distilled water. We do not recommend adding liquids other than water to the kettle.
3. When ironing extremely wrinkled clothing, please iron from the inside or underneath. The weight of the fabric against the steam helps remove wrinkles faster.
4. After re-steaming, let the garment rest for 5-10 minutes before wearing or hanging in the closet. This will give your clothes enough time to dry.
5. Always empty the water canister after use to prevent mold growth.
6. Make sure the water level in the tank is below the max line.

## **FAQs**

### **What kind of water do you use in a Hilife HL7 handheld steamer?**

Overall, one of the best water types to use in clothing steamers is distilled water. In fact, because it improves the performance and durability of the steamer, you'll find that many clothing steamers on the market specifically recommend using this type of water.

### **How often should you empty the water from the Hilife HL7 steamer?**

In other words, do not let water remain in your steam appliance for longer than 30 days. We advise draining the water from your steam appliance every 30 days.

### **How many times should you use a Hilife HL7 steamer?**

Most skin types with less sensitive skin can steam two to three times per week. According to Diliberto, oily skin is typically thicker and can withstand more frequent steaming. If you have thinner or drier skin, once per week is sufficient.

### **Can you use a Hilife HL7 steamer without water?**

Yes. Simply unplug your steam iron, allow it to cool, and then empty the water tank to remove the water from the iron. Turn the dial to the dry/steam setting, if your iron has one, or to the "MIN" setting, if it doesn't have a dry/steam setting.

### **Why tap water is used in Hilife HL7 steamer?**

We explain the rationale for using tap water in the steamer in this article. Electricity does not conduct well through water. Pure water cannot be used with a steamer for the straightforward reason that it does not conduct electricity.

### **What is the temperature in a Hilife HL7 handheld steam cleaner?**

Internal boilers in steam cleaners heat water to temperatures as high as 325 degrees Fahrenheit. When water is heated to these levels, it turns into extremely hot steam that can be used to enter microscopic pores on a variety of surfaces.

## **Can you leave water in Hilife HL7 steamer overnight?**

Never let the steamer sit with water in it overnight. Due to the mineral deposits that accumulate from daily use, neglected steamers frequently spit hot water. Use a vinegar and water cleaning solution.

## **How do you clean a Hilife HL7 portable steamer?**

**Clean and Soak the Nozzle:** Soak the nozzle for at least eight hours or overnight in the warm vinegar. Rinse the nozzle thoroughly in warm water after removal. To gently remove any deposits from each nozzle, use a toothpick. Repeatedly rinse, then pat dry with a towel.

## **Can I reuse the water in Hilife HL7 steamer?**

Think of it as “soup” or stock. It’s simple to pour it off into a container and put it in the refrigerator once it’s cool enough to handle.

## **How effective is Hilife HL7 steam cleaning?**

High temperatures of up to 220°F are used by steam cleaners, such as garment steamers and steam mops, to kill 99.9% of germs, bacteria, viruses, mould, mildew, allergens, and insects like bed bugs and dust mites. It is a natural alternative to cleaning and sanitising your home, place of employment, and clothing.

## **How long is an effective steaming?**

Don’t steam longer than 10 to 15 minutes for each session. However, you can repeat steam inhalation two or three times per day if you’re still having symptoms. You can also purchase an electric steam inhaler (also called a vaporizer) online or at a drugstore.

## **What are the side effects of steam inhalation?**

The lining of your lungs can become damaged if you breathe in very hot water. If you have asthma, it can be especially bad because it can make your asthma symptoms worse. Some people believe that adding eucalyptus oil to the water will make the steam more fragrant and help them breathe easier.

## **What are the disadvantages of steaming?**

Compared to boiling, it takes more time. It uses more energy during cooking. It frequently lacks flavor.

## **What is a Hilife HL7 steam temperature?**

A steam bath should be heated to a temperature of 110 to 115 degrees Fahrenheit. The humidity level in steam rooms should be kept at around 100%. But keep in mind that you can modify our system to suit your preferences.

## **How do you know when Hilife HL7 steam cleaner is ready?**

Depending on the machine you have, the unit will finish heating in 3-5 minutes, at which point the indicator light will turn off. This signaled that the water was hot and that you could start steam cleaning.
